

In the morning, we'll visit the Po Nagar Cham Towers, built in AD 781—one of Vietnam's oldest historical sites. After the visit, you'll transfer approximately 80 minutes to the Hon Gom Peninsula. From there, you'll begin cycling along the peninsula, passing shrimp farms and the largest rice paddies in central Vietnam, en route to Phu Yen.

Day 10 will be the most challenging but rewarding day of the entire trip.

The day will start with a short transfer out of the town and a ride along the coast to Da Nang before starting the climb to the world-famous Hai Van Pass. The road climbs gradually up to 480 meters with many switchbacks and offers stunning views of the countryside overlooking the East Sea.

This tough climb is followed by a long smooth descent to your reward: lunch. In the afternoon we will continue to ride seashore for another 44 km before getting to Hue, the old capital of the Nguyen Dynasty




